# PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

## **CONSTRUCTION ZONE: BUILDING SUCCESS IN EARLY CHILDHOOD**

**Grade: Students Entering Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade**

The first years of elementary school call for big steps in a child's life. This class will prepare your little learner for a rewarding year. Children will put on their homemade tool belts and hammer out math problems, measure scientific observations, and build word dominoes. Indoor and outdoor games will strengthen listening and cooperative skills while daily stories and journaling reinforce literacy skills. Activities include gardening and painting, so be sure to bring a cover-up.

## **CONSTRUCTION ZONE: BUILDING A HOME**

**Grade: Students Entering 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Children will harness their vivid imaginations and creativity to construct a house using creative materials. The day begins with a soccer camp that will lay the foundation for good health while improving players' techniques, foot skills, and field play. As students plan and design their home, they will learn reading and writing skills that create the blueprint for academic success. Exciting games will refresh math facts to provide the structural reinforcement young students need. Finally, students will learn to make their house a home with touches of gardening and baking.

## **CONSTRUCTION ZONE: ERECTING A ROLLER COASTER**

**Grades: Students Entering 6<sup>th</sup> Grade- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**

This is a camp for junior high students to "build up" their minds and bodies. The morning portion of the camp will be filled with soccer activities designed to improve players' techniques, foot skills, and field play. This will lay the foundation for the student planning to participate in competitive sports during the upcoming school year. In the afternoon, students will switch gears and become roller coaster engineers. Using various concepts in physics and math, as well as their creativity and ingenuity, they will design their own fantasy roller coasters, working together to develop the fastest or longest coasters possible with the materials available. The last day of camp will feature the ultimate coaster experience—a trip to Great America where the students can fully appreciate and experience the thrill of real life roller coasters.
